## Tryout Information- May 14

This season, our tryout process will be in two sessions split by age. The tryout will be low stress. Athletes should be prepared to jump, tumble, and learn a very short dance they will perform at tryouts. Athletes need to have their hair pulled up in a ponytail and wear black spandex shorts/sports bra/tank top at tryouts.

Because the industry standards are always changing and become more competitive each year, we will be very selective in our placement process. If an athlete does not get placed on an All-Star Elite team, they will be offered a spot on one of our prep teams for the season.

## Team Placements

Decisions are made based on numerous factors, such as tumbling, jumps, performance, age, and maturity. Having certain level tumbling skills does not mean that an athlete will be placed on a team of that same level. Athletes will be placed where the coaches feel is in their best interest. ## Financial Expectations

Our monthly tuition pricing includes team training, tumbling, choreo/music fees, competition fees, and extra practices.

Tuition payments begin in June 2022 and run through May 2023. All families must sign up for automatic payment with a debit/credit card.

## Practices

Team members are expected to attend all scheduled practices. Teams will practice 2-3 times a week, each practice will be 2-3 hours. Practices will begin the week of June 6, 2022 and continue through May of 2023. Once competition season starts there will be additional practices scheduled.

## Practice Wear

Each athlete will receive 2 coordinating practice wear sets for team practices. Coaches will designate which practice wear set is to be worn on a specific day. Each athlete is expected to wear the correct practice outfit to practice ALL SEASON. If a piece of practice wear is lost or damaged during the season you will be responsible for purchasing a replacement. White cheer shoes should be worn at every practice. Any brand of cheer shoe is acceptable.

## Uniforms

We will have the same uniform as last season. If you are needing to purchase a new one, the cost is \$450. We MAY have some uniforms for resale at half-price. Details regarding resale will be sent out after teams begin practicing.

Uniform cost does not include hair accessories such as bow or scrunchies, uniform socks, or cheer shoes. All athletes needing to wear a bra underneath their uniform **must** purchase a clear strap bra.

## Competitions

All Star Elite teams will compete at 6-8 competitions. We will finalize our competition schedule as soon as possible. Most competitions will take place in the DFW metroplex, but we plan on attending at least 1 out of town competition. Parents entrance fees to competitions and travel expenses are not included in our pricing.

### IMPORTANT

- There is a possibility that some teams may compete on a Friday or have to miss school for travel during competition season.
- Event producers do change dates and/or times unexpectedly. If that happens, we may have to alter our competition schedule throughout the season.
- ALL competitions our teams go to are not optional, this includes end of the season BID events. If you are not interested in attending an out-of-town event then we recommend not trying out for an All-Star Elite team.

## Athlete Attendance

All-Star cheerleading is a select sport. Full commitment is required from both the athlete and the family. Before trying out, we ask that athletes and parents please consider the time and attendance requirements in order to avoid conflicts. This sport demands a very high commitment level making it difficult for the athlete to be involved in a variety of other activities. In order for the team to be successful, all athletes on a team need to be at practice. We will do our best to accommodate school cheer schedules but we will NOT work around additional activities. We reserve the right to remove an athlete from a team if they have habitual absences.

During the summer, each athlete is allowed 6 absences, which totals 3 weeks. We do recommend not taking all of those absences consecutively in order to maintain their current skills. Summer is a great time for growth for athletes it is very important to be at practice during the summer when in town.

During the school year, the only excused absences are contagious illness, funeral, or a school function that result in a grade. Part time jobs, homework, studying, birthday parties, family reunions, vacations, not having a ride, personal issues, etc. will be unexcused.

Again, all athletes are expected to attend all competitions, including those that are out of town. If an athlete misses a competition and we have to pull the team from competing due to that absence, *that team member will be responsible for the amount to refund each team members competition fees.*
